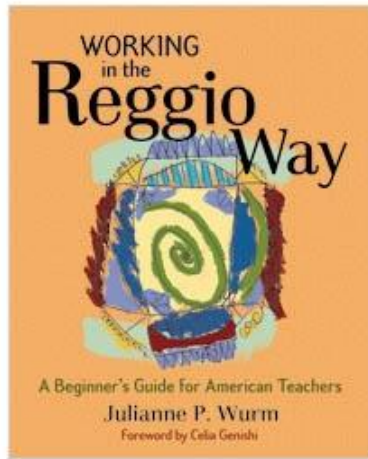


Workshop for Educators
